

# Hôtel de Toiras, Saint-Martin-de-Ré

The Hôtel de Toiras, located at the entrance to the harbour of Saint-Martin-de-Ré, has taken advantage of its closure to undertake a transformation in partnership with designer Pierre-Yves Rochon.



George's has an informal lounge and a new contemporary brasserie on the water's edge with a large terrace looking on the Saint-Martin-de-Ré harbour.

New chef Gregory Vingadassalon will showcase local produce, particularly seafood or dishes inspired by the ocean.

Le Salon d'Olivia has also been altered, creating a new living space located next to a bar and opening onto a patio, landscaped by designer Louis Benech.

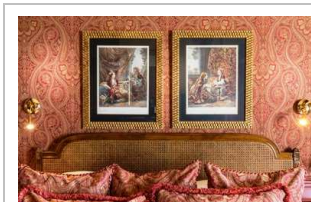
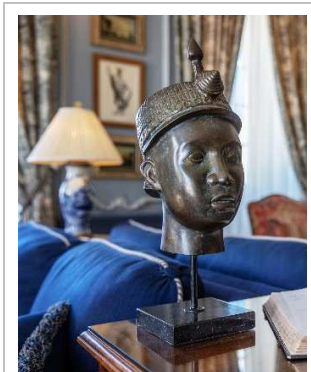
Saint-Martin-de-Ré, a UNESCO World Heritage Site, is a port town on the Île de Ré, an island off the west coast of France.

It's ringed by star-shaped, 17th-century ramparts, with a preserved citadel on the eastern side.

Cafes and restaurants with outdoor terraces surround the busy harbour.

Le Clocher Observatoire clock tower offers views over the town and the Musée Ernest Cognacq has artifacts, ceramics and paintings, plus a sculpture garden.
